Visitors will be able to see ExB preDICT®, a new way of entering text, based on a learning database that adapts itself to the user's vocabulary, even in different languages. The predictive algorithm allows users to complete sentences by selecting from predicted full words instead of constructing words by tapping single letters. Early testing demonstrates that the full-word system allows much faster text-input performance.

ExB preDICT® is available in 74 languages, more than any other competing solution and will be available on the Android AppStore from February 15th in an increasing number of languages.
